

CADELL BORDER LEICESTER 2014 ANNUAL SALE REPORT

Stud rams topped at \$4,250 in an almost total clearance at the 39th annual Ram Sale at Cadell.

Murray and Scott Brown from ‘Glamis’ stud at Bedgerebong were the successful purchasers of this ram. The ‘Glamis’ stud, which was established in 1931, has been a long-time client of Cadell’s. The ram they bought, No.227-13 was sired by Superior the 4th, one of the old established blood-lines of Cadell. This ram’s twin brother, No. 226-13 was purchased by Peter Richardson’s ‘Elerada’ Stud from Corowa, for \$3,800.

Jeff Sutton of ‘Wattle Farm’ purchased two stud rams, one at \$3,800 and one at \$2,000. The twelve stud rams averaged \$2,425.

Flock rams were very keenly sought after with 145 sold at an average of \$970. The top priced flock ram was purchased by Bruce Rollins from Rannock for \$1500. This was part of the six he put together.

Other buyers included: Noel and Peter Wilson, Ungarie, 12 to a top of \$1300
David Watt, Trundle, 12 to a top of \$1200.

The two top-priced ewes were \$500, purchased by Deleware Past., Co., Brocklesby. Will Stanley, from, Galong, who is starting up a new stud, purchased six ewes to a top of \$400.

Buyers were present from all parts of NSW, Victoria and Qld.

The agents conducting the sale were Elders and Landmark, both from Wagga.
